Sub: Estt – I & CAD Department – TSMS – Promotions issued from the Junior Assistant/ Typist post to Senior Assistant post and from Senior Assistant post to Superintendent post – Irregular Promotions Noticed – Instructions for review of irregular promotions- – Issued -Regarding.

In continuation to this office circular memo 2nd cited, it is informed that the Government vide G.O.Ms.No.627, GA (Ser. A) Department, Dated: 21.12.1983 have reduced the minimum period of 5 years of service prescribed for promotion from one category to another category to three years. However it is stated in the GO that in no case shall it be less than two years in the category.

Further, it was clarified vide Para 5 of the Government Memo No. 53975/ Ser. D/ 2000-3, Dated: 09.01.2001 that, a person appointed or promoted on adhoc or temporary basis without fulfilling the required number of years of service in the feeder category, by invoking rule 10(a) of the A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 (Now T.S. State & Subordinate Service Rules), may be allowed to count his service in higher category or class as the case may be to the extent of the period of duty performed by him in the latter service during which he would have held the post in the former service but for such appointment in the latter service and the probation of such individual so promoted or appointed may have to be commenced from the next date of such completion of the required period of service in the lower category.

In this regard, it is informed that, on review of the promotions accorded to certain Superintendents, from the report received from circles/ unit offices in response to the Circular Memo 1st read above, it is noticed that, certain Superintendents were promoted from one cadre to another cadre, without completion of the minimum service prescribed in the cadres of Office Subordinate, Typist, Junior Assistant and Senior Assistant in deviation of service rules and Government orders. i.e., without completion of three years of service in the feeder cadres as per para-8 of APMS rules and Five Years of service in the Last grade service as per para-6 of APMS rules. Further it is noticed that, the date of commencement was not assigned as per the Government Memo No. 53975/ Ser. D/ 2000-3, Dated: 09.01.2001, where the promotion was accorded, without fulfilling the required number of years of service in the feeder category.
