Sub: Estt. – Telangana Irrigation Engineering Service Rules 2018 – Rendering field service of (2) years as Assistant Executive Engineer to become eligible for promotion to the post of Deputy Executive Engineer and (2) years field service as Deputy Executive Engineer to become eligible for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer in the Department – Instructions issued – Reg.

In continuation to this office circular memo 4th cited, all the In-charge Executive Engineers, Deputy Executive Engineers and Assistant Executive Engineers are hereby informed that Government in the G.O. 1st cited issued Telangana Irrigation Engineering Service Rules-2018, which came into force from 10-05-2018 i.e., the date of publication of the G.O. in the Telangana State Gazette. As per the Rule (7) of the said Rules, the Assistant Executive Engineers should render minimum five years of service, out of which two years should be field service to become eligible for promotion to the cadre of Deputy Executive Engineer. Similarly, the Deputy Executive Engineers should render minimum five years of service, out of which two years should be field service to become eligible for promotion to the cadre of Executive Engineer.

The Screening Committee in the Committee Meeting held on 26-03-2020, while considering ad-hoc promotions from the cadre of Assistant Executive Engineer to the cadre of Deputy Executive Engineer for the panel year 2019-20, decided to exempt the Assistant Executive Engineers who are not having the required (2) years field service at present as a one-time measure and to consider their cases for ad-hoc promotion as Deputy Executive Engineer, subject to condition that they have to complete four years of field service (i.e. including 2 years of field service not done in Assistant Executive Engineer cadre) before next promotion to the cadre of Executive Engineer.

Therefore, the Assistant Executive Engineers who are not having 2 year of field service and promoted as Deputy Executive Engineers vide reference 5th cited shall render total (4) years of field service as Deputy Executive Engineer to become eligible for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer.

Further, the Deputy Executive Engineers who are placed as In-charge Executive Engineers after issue of the Telangana Irrigation Engineering Service Rules-2018 i.e., 10-05-2018 and who have not rendered the requisite (2) years field service as Deputy Executive Engineers shall render 2 years of field service as Deputy Executive Engineer and I/c Executive Engineer put together to become eligible for promotion to the post of Executive Engineer on regular basis.

In view of the above, the Assistant Executive Engineers promoted as Deputy Executive Engineers and the Deputy Executive Engineers who are placed as In-charge Executive Engineers after 10-05-2018 without having (2) years of field service, are hereby advised to complete the required field service to become eligible for consideration to the regular promotion as Executive Engineer.
