Sub: Court Cases-Prompt Submission of latest written instructions, Appraising case details to the Special GP/GP/AGPs in pending court cases- Nominating one legal officer per unit-Regarding.

The attention of all the unit officers of the Irrigation & CAD Department is invited to the reference cited above, wherein instructions were issued to all the Unit officers of the department for deputing one well-acquainted officer with the facts of the cases from each unit to assist the AG/AAG/GP & AGP in the cases listed for hearing by elucidating their cases and submitting the relevant information, finalizing the Counter affidavits. Whereas it is observed that no officer has been deputed to attend High Court duties till now from the Unit Offices.

Further, it is observed that some of the officers are just posting the Written instructions along with enclosures of their case in the WhatsApp legal group and also to the concerned AGPs. Whereas the GP/APGs are demanding a hard copy of the Written instruction to be produced in the Court Hall during the hearing of the matter and an explanation of the case from a person who is well acquainted with the case.

At present, there are about 3850 pending cases out of 6073 total cases in Hon'ble High Court and the abstract of pending court cases of each unit office has been enclosed for ready reference. It can be observed that on average only 28 % of counter's affidavits



have been filed in the pending court cases. The pending cases list is increasing rapidly day by day. The present 3 member Liasning team who has been working for the last 5 years is not sufficient to cater for the 3815 pending cases. It was advised by the GP, I&CAD that as a normal practice in Home and Revenue depts. etc, there are liaison officers from each District for the smooth handling of their court cases and the same practice may be adopted in the I&CAD dept for efficient disposal of the cases.

In this regard, all the Unit officers are once again requested to nominate one officer from their unit who is well versed with the court procedure to pursue their unit cases with AG/AAG/GP offices to the High Court. The nominated officer shall obtain written Instructions and details of the case from the concerned and appraise facts of the case to the GP/AGP. Contact details of the nominated officer may be furnished to this Office.
